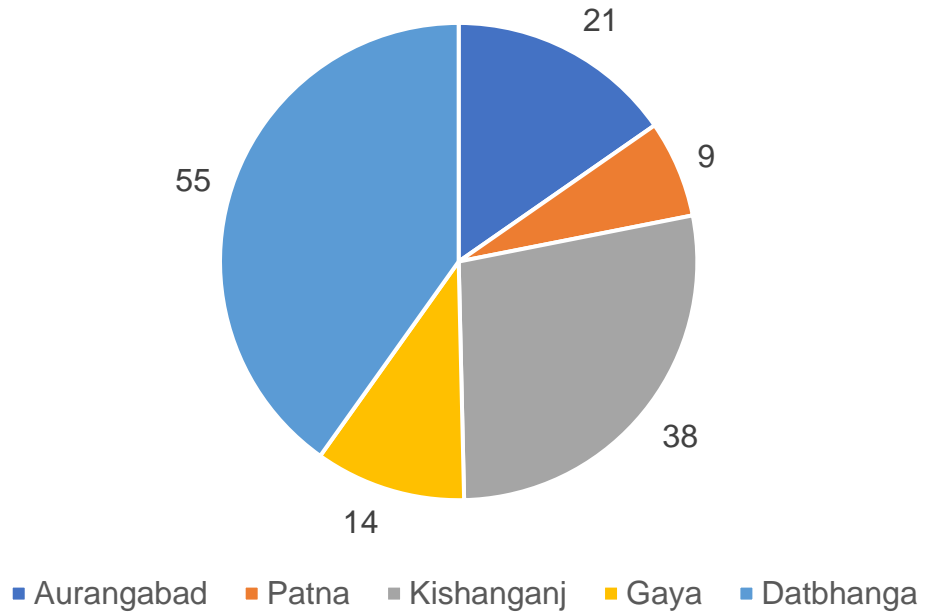

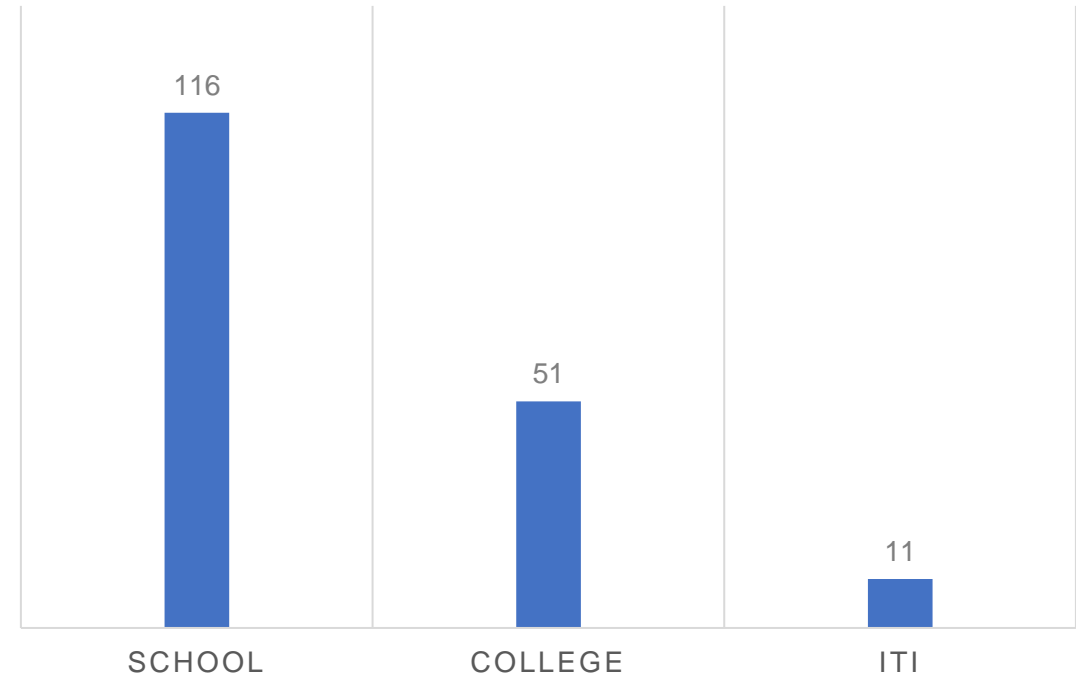

Top districts in KYC



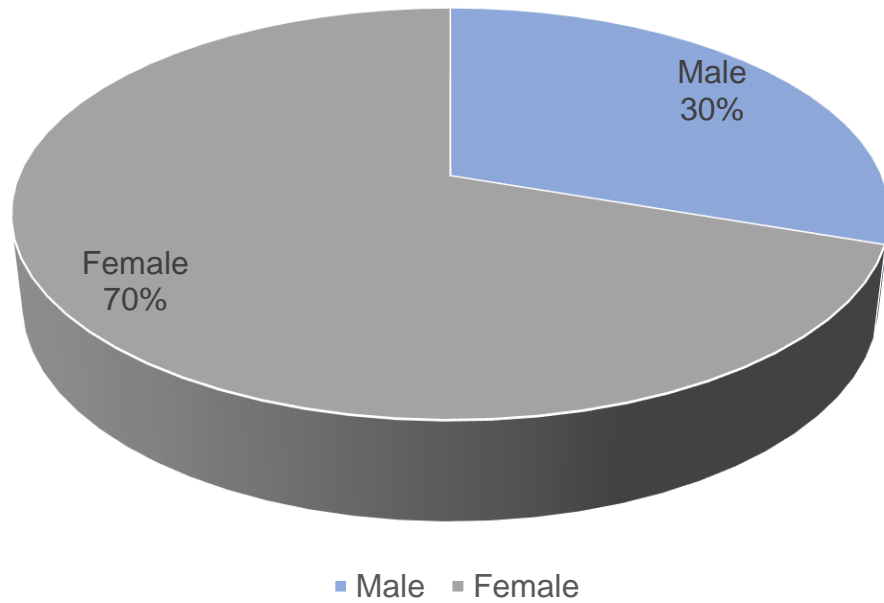

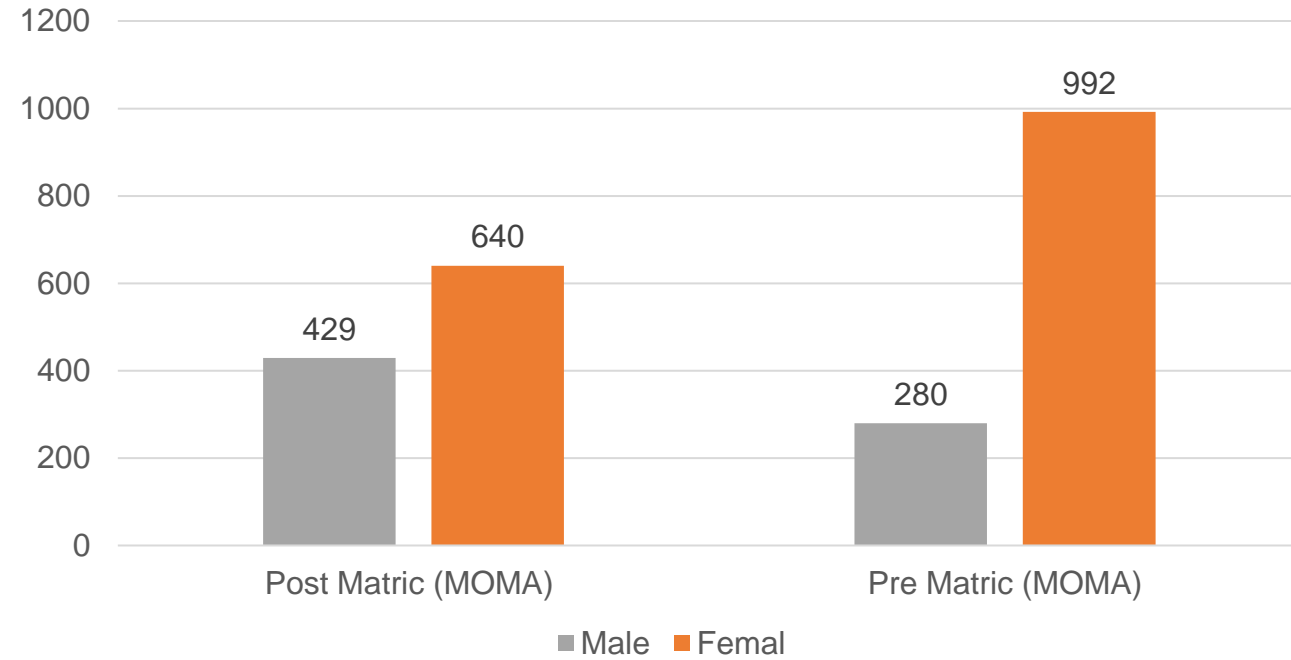

## Male & Female Ratio



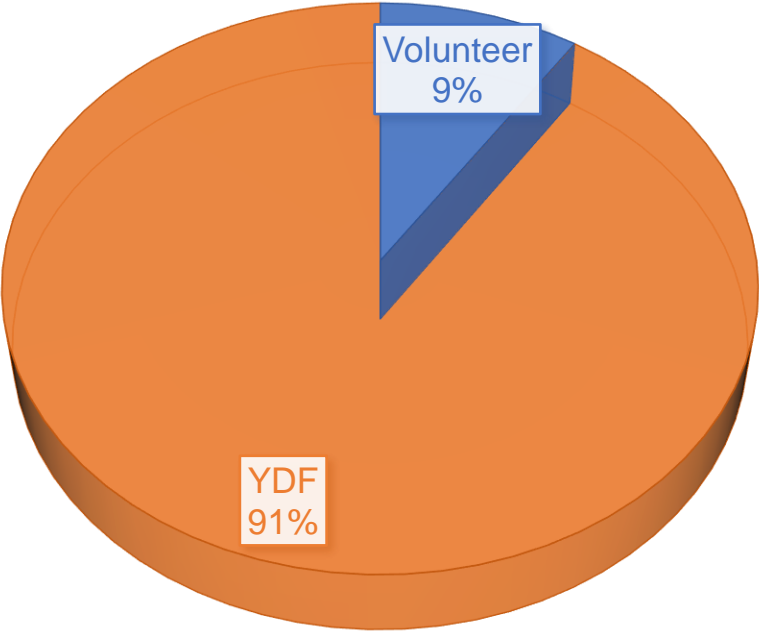

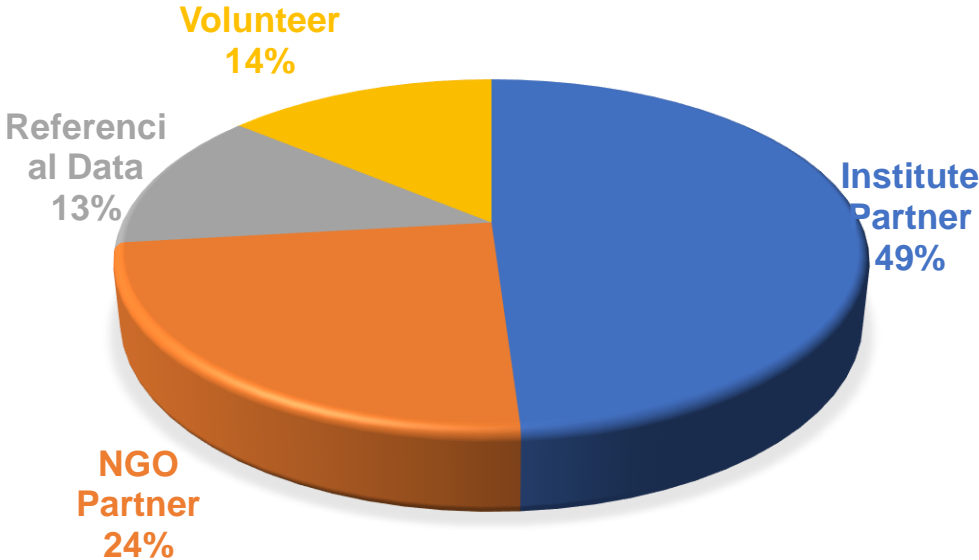

## INSTITUTE KYC

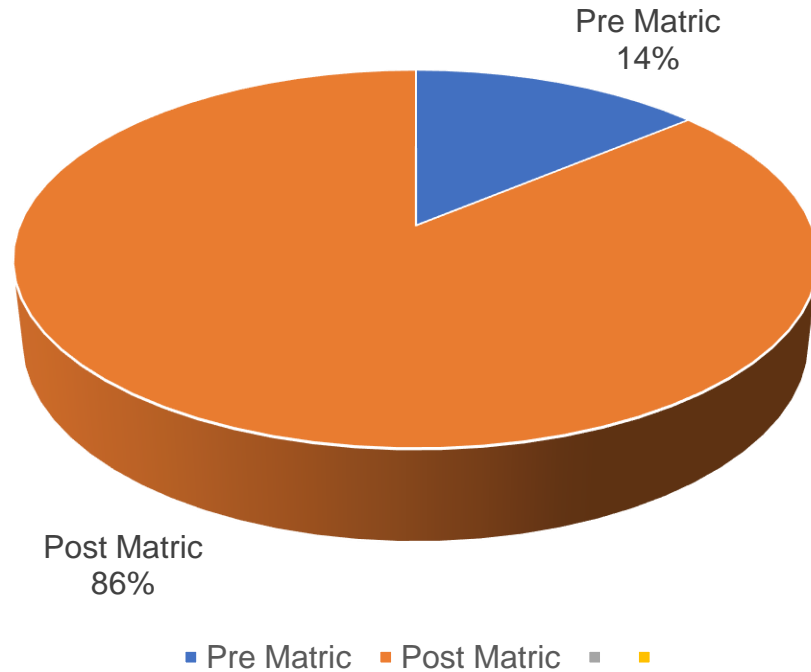


## MODE OF DATA COLLECTION FOR STUDENTS APPLICATION

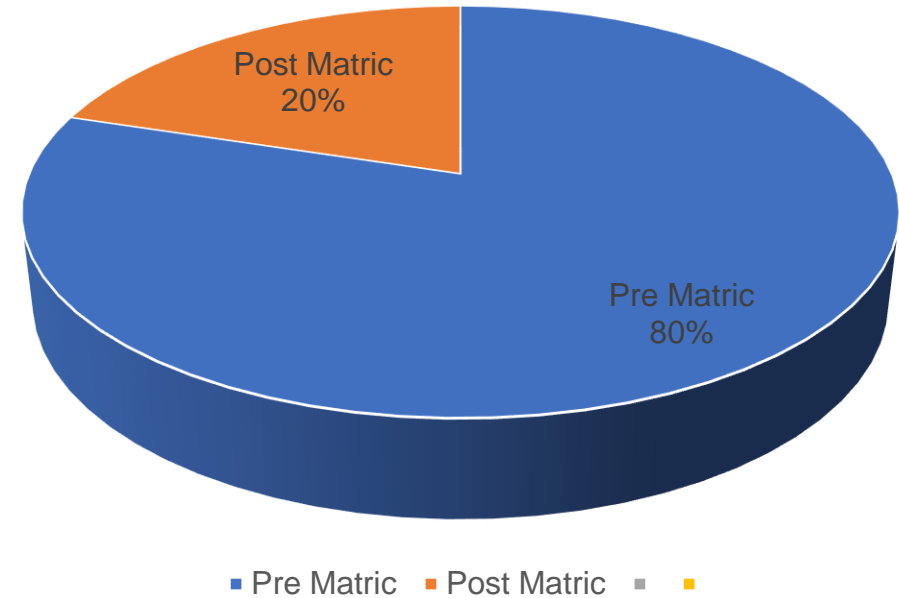

# Challenges & Learning

<b>Gaya</b>	<p>The major challenge faced while doing the application in Gaya for pre- matrics on NSP scheme 2019-20 was to verify OTP. Apart from this, we were to do field visits to the various institution and schools for collecting data but due to covid schools and colleges were not operating as usual so we had to collect the data on call, during which a lot of trust issues were arising from students' side.</p>
	<p>Also apart from all the above challenges, in the year 2019-20 govt. reverted the form that made students go to institutes and re-verify the application. Many students were unable to verify their application either because of no document or because of a server issue.</p>
	<p>In Gaya, because Internal factors like electricity problems and external factors like covid made the work hamper a lot and for such reasons, we made the shift of the office to Patna in mid-session. And, after that working with stakeholders of Gaya was quite challenging.</p>
<b>Patna</b>	<p>Due to covid, we were not able to make visits to our liaison institutes from where we collect data and do applications for students by visiting the field. most of the students were from pre-matric so collecting documents and verifying OTP was a great challenge.</p>
	<p>The response of INOs to verification was such that MoMA application verification was their additional task and they have a lot of work pressure so they are sometimes unable to verify the application also there is no other staff in support for such tasks.</p>
	<p>The major problem arose during the Verification of the application by INOs. As it was mentioned on the portal that application exceeding 50k should upload their documents But during verification INOs mentioned no application will be accepted with one or No documents uploaded.</p>
<b>Kishanganj</b>	<p>In kishanganj, we were working with pre-matric students and the major challenge there was of understanding the language they used.</p>
	<p>The other challenge was, that the DNOs have instructed the INOs not to verify the applications received under the MoMA scheme and they were free to reject the application form. Only they can opt for State govt. schemes like Balika Cycle Yojna; Mukhyamantri Poshak Yojna; Mukhyamantri Balika Poshak Yojna etc.</p>
